

Yeshiva Ketana Dress Code for Grades 1-8

Appropriate clothes are important to enhance school decorum and instill in children a respectful attitude towards school.

- Shirts must have collars; shirts with writing, numbers, large logos, or large pictures may not be worn. For Junior High School students, shirts should be solid white or blue, with no stripes (full button down or three button polo).
- Boys must wear dark pants. Jeans, cargo pants, tight-fitting pants, sweatpants, or shorts may not be worn.
- Shoes and/or sneakers and their laces must be a conservative color. For Junior High School students, only **fully black sneakers (including soles) with black laces are allowed, even in the gym.** [These can be purchased from Incredible Feet, or you can choose from a large selection on-line].
- **Only school sweatshirts purchased through Lands End will be allowed.** Elementary School students may choose between a hooded or non-hooded sweatshirt. Junior High School students can only purchase non-hooded sweatshirts. Our Preferred School Number for LandsEnd.com is 900169830.
- Proper sized dark colored yarmulkes are required without secular pictures, logos, or writing other than the student's name or initial. **For Junior High School students, only solid dark colored yarmulkes without any writing at all. (even initials are not allowed)**
- All boys who already wear תפילין are required to wear hats and jackets for all Davening in school.
- All hats must be felt and not rain hat material. All jackets should be dark conservative colors.

We thank you for your positive attitude towards conforming with the expectations of our school. This is critical for enabling your children to develop a healthy and mature acceptance of authority.
